MIGRATION PROTOCOL TO METC PROGRAM

Medical Equipment Training and Certification LLC, (METC) has been asked by several installers about migrating their documentation over from other issuing companies.

The advantage to migrating is that METC issues documentation good for three years. A brazing continuity form is issued with class documentation. Every six months after this, students will have to complete a nitrogen-purged brazed joint in front of a witness and have the witness sign the brazing continuity form. This joint may be a medical gas joint, a refrigeration joint or a sample set up in a shop. This form is kept active by the student and submitted at the time of their next renewal. Renewals are good for 3 years.

The current fee of \$250 is the cost to purchase the NFPA 99 2018 Edition Code Book. If only a test is needed, the cost is \$125. There is also a one-time migration fee of \$125. The costs listed are per student.

There is no requirement for purchasing a new wallet card every six months!

Should someone wish to migrate from another program to the METC program, we would need the following.

1. Payment
2. A copy of their current ASSE card
3. A digital photo, passport quality (jpeg. format) emailed to us
4. A copy of their current QB-484 brazing certificate or wallet card from another acceptable company (see No. 2 above)
5. A completed application (attached)
